# After School Program

We provide a dynamic array of programs and activities for school-age children in a safe, nurturing, flexible and welcoming environment that supports their families' needs. Programming focuses on a healthy combination of constructive play, child- and counselor-led activities, active play and Judaic culture. Everyone is welcomed and encouraged to become vital members of our programs.



The JCC's After School Program offers school-age children a safe place to go for fun, educational and recreational activities. Our choice-based program gives children freedom and flexibility to pursue their interests. From sports and clubs to available enrichment classes, we've got so much for children to do each day after school!

We serve the Syracuse Hebrew Day School and other area private schools, east-area Syracuse City Schools, Jamesville-DeWitt Schools and Fayetteville-Manlius Schools. In many cases, the JCC's own bus can even provide transportation to the program. Membership not required; discount for JCC of Syracuse members.

Daily duties will include planning and implementing activities, troubleshooting behaviors and engaging children. This is not a job to merely sit and watch children.

Typical hours are Monday - Friday from 3:00 - 6:00pm. Staff work anywhere from 2-5 days a week.

Participants must have a love for children and have previous experience working with kids.

There is an option for more hours when the children are off from school.
